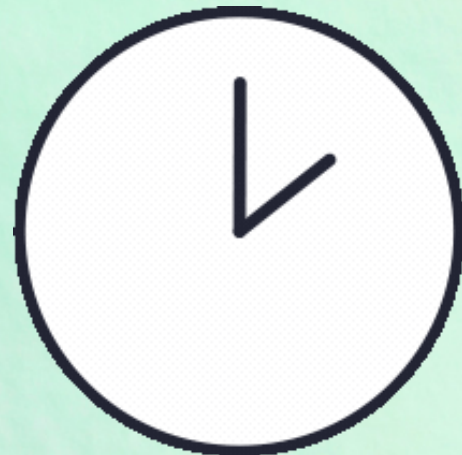
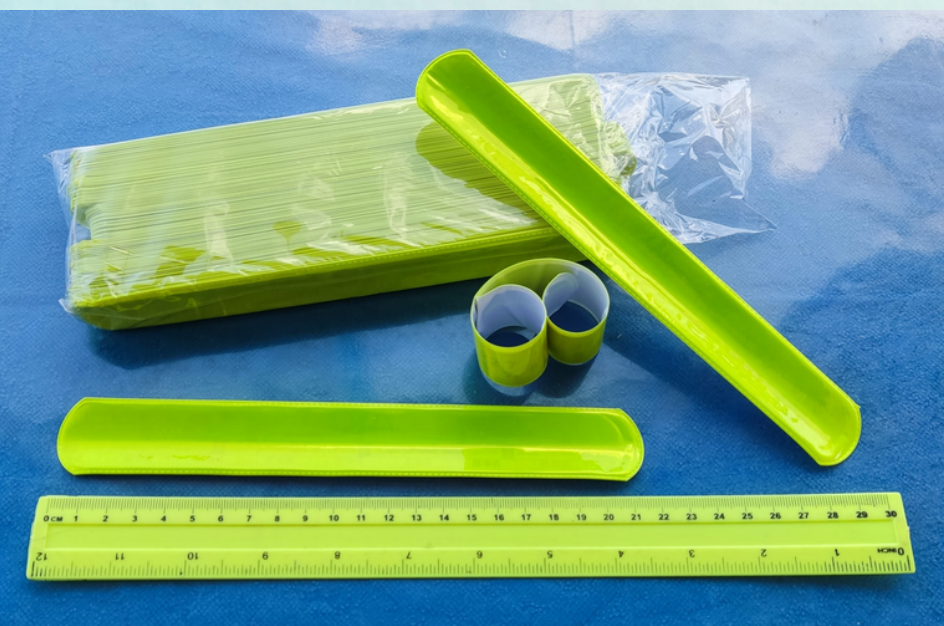


5. Everything I got in the Terratech game was deleted. It's a relatively old game, so it's impossible to restore. I got good things one day, and the next day they were gone.



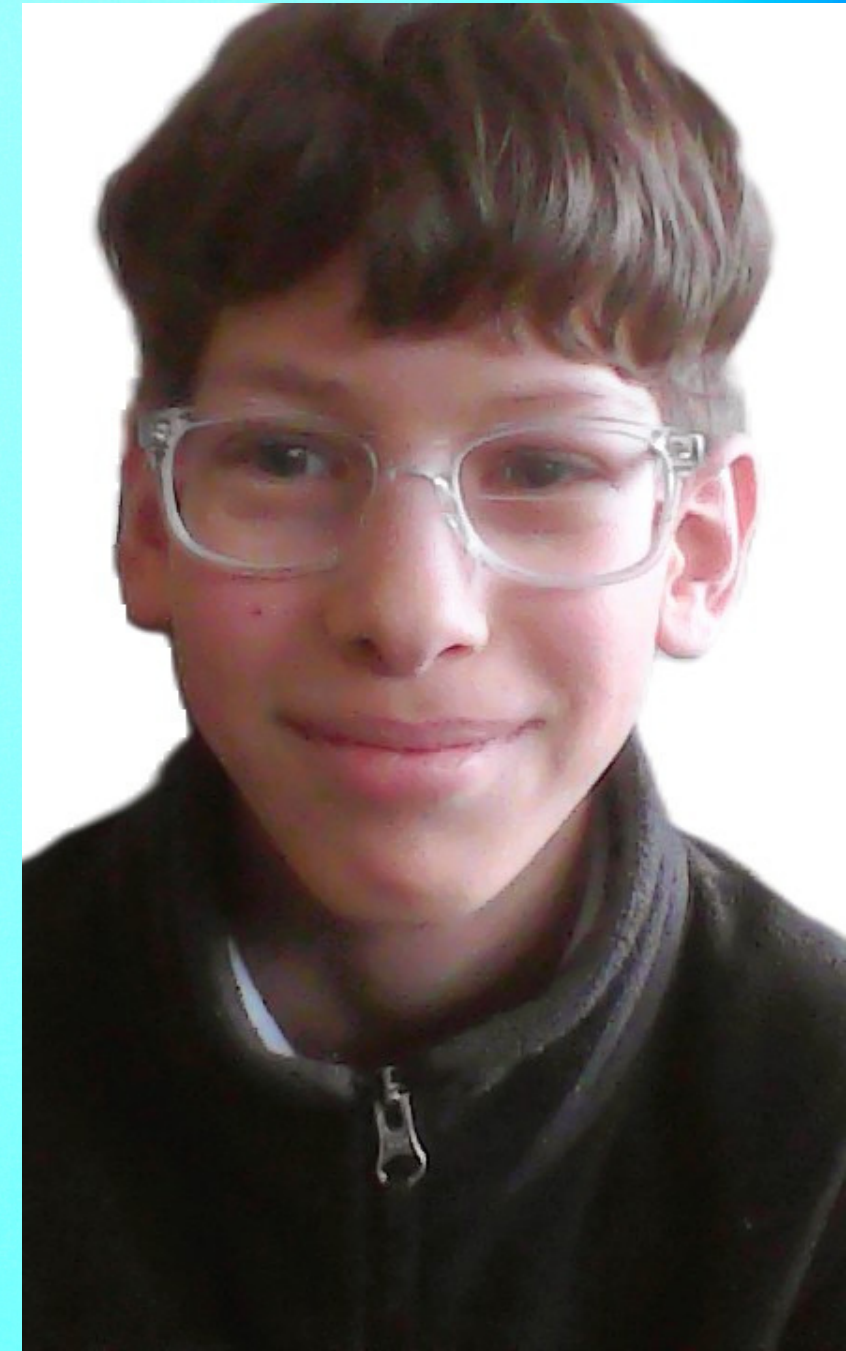
ONE OF MY HAPPIEST MEMORIES
